Thanks to these periods we can distinguish his paintings very well, and the people who are not so familiar with art are able to understand his ideas and know what he wanted to express with them. Furthermore Picasso was a convinced political activist. He painted “Guernica”, one of the greatest pieces of art that has ever been seen and which is directed against the war and the despair that is caused by it. During the civil war this village in the Basque region was brutally bombed and Picasso painted this huge image with the intention to denounce this to the whole world. If you are interested you can take a look at the painting at the Queen Sofia Museum, which is located in Madrid as well. Its enormous size and its grey and black colours evoke overwhelming emotions.

Despite this very academical education, Picasso is, as we have already mentioned, worldwide known for his break with the tradition. His painting “The Young Ladies of Avignon” was not only a milestone of cubism, but also one of the pieces of art, which has truly made a new artistic movement out of cubism. One of the most peculiar things of Picasso's career as an artist are the periods that he had and which are very famous as well. These periods were known as the rose period, the blue period, the analytical cubism, the hermetic cubism, the surrealist cubism, the cold cubism... It had many different stages!

After the civil war Picasso spent his life in France, where he passed away and was buried. His family belonged to the upper bourgeoisie of Málaga, which has provided him access to a privileged education for that time. This fact, combined with his special sensitivity, that has been existing since his childhood, resulted in an early interest in arts. Already in 1889 at the age of only eight years he painted his first pictures, driven by his father who had wanted to become an artist as well. In 1897 when he still was very young he went to Madrid to study at one of the most remarkable academies of that time, the “Royal Academy of Fine Arts” in San Fernando. If you are interested you can still visit it today in the centre of Madrid. It is one of the most recommended visits for art enthusiasts.
